AMFA – SWA Contract Proposal Prioritization Survey Notice – 2012

In accordance with Article XXIII, Section 3 of the AMFA Constitution, AMFA National is conducting a survey to prioritize proposals submitted for the upcoming AMFA – Southwest Airlines contract negotiations. This survey gives you an opportunity to indicate your opinion of the level of importance for each proposal by ranking it High, Neutral, or Low priority, and the results of this prioritization vote will be given to the Contract Negotiation Committee to be used during the contract negotiation process. The complete text of the 153 compiled proposals will be displayed on the survey website.

This survey is being conducted via the internet, and all active AMFA members in good standing under the Southwest Airlines Mechanics' Collective Bargaining Agreement are eligible to participate in this survey. **Note:** Any member whose membership dues, fees, and/or assessment obligations have not been paid in full is a member in bad standing, and therefore, their response will be eliminated prior to the tally. Members are strongly urged to resolve any arrearage prior to the tally so their response will be counted.

The Survey Notice and Instructions will be mailed to eligible participants at the address on file with AMFA National as of February 1, 2012. Any eligible member who has not received instructions in the mail by February 10, 2012, or anyone having questions about the voting process, should contact the Elections Administrator at 720-744-6629.
